



It all started with a bang in 2014 when downtown Albany's Wellington Hotel annex was imploded to make way for a new convention center. Opened in March 2017, the Albany Capital Center (ACC), joining the Empire State Plaza Convention Center, Egg Performing Arts Center and MVP Arena, created the 159,000-square-foot, walkway-connected Capital Complex, Upstate New York's largest combined meeting venue. Housing 22.500 square feet of multi-purpose space, 9,200 square feet of meeting space, 13,500 square feet of prefunction area and six meeting rooms, the ACC has generated \$62.1 million in total new-visitor spending.




