





Agriculture/Food:

Agriculture and local food systems account for about 10 percent of the Capital Region's employment. Notable area food and beverage producers include soft drink manufacturer Adirondack Beverages, spaghetti sauce maker Casa Visco, sausage manufacturer Belinski and several breweries, such as Druthers and Brown's Brewing.

Creative Economy:

The local creative industry employs more than 24,000 residents, with Columbia County having the nation's third highest concentration of independent artists. In all, there are 21 video game studios in the Capital Region employing 418 people, according to the CEG survey results. Sixteen of those studios are independent, working as contractors or volunteers.

Transportation and Logistics:

Our region employs over 14,000 individuals at hubs such as the Port of Albany, Port of Coeymans and fulfillment centers for companies such as Ace Hardware, Coca-Cola, FedEx, UPS and Target.
